



John Maduro

John Maduro is a radiation oncologist at the University Medical Center Groningen and Princess Maxima Center for Pediatric Oncology. He completed his medical degree from the University of Leiden, and his residency in Radiation Oncology from the UMCG. In 2009, he received a Ph.D. in Medical Science from the University of Groningen.

Dr. Maduro has received training in clinical and experimental oncology, radiobiology and clinical cancer research. He has also been awarded a personal research grant from the Dutch Cancer Society for preclinical laboratory research. He is a reviewer for multiple oncology journals and has several publications especially on breast cancer and pediatric oncology.

Dr. Maduro is an active member of several professional societies, including ESTRO, ASTRO, PROS, ASCO, PTCOG, SIOP, SIOPE, Euro Ewing Consortium (EEC), and European Paediatric Soft Tissue Sarcoma Study Group (EpSSG). He has held several leadership positions, including serving as the chairman of the Landelijk Platform Radiotherapie Mamma carcinoom (LPRM), and on the board of the Dutch Breast Cancer Research Group (BOOG), and the National Dutch Breast Cancer Consultation (NABON).

Dr. Maduro has been active as a pediatric radiation oncologist since 2006 and has been involved in the national (pediatric) proton therapy program since 2018.
