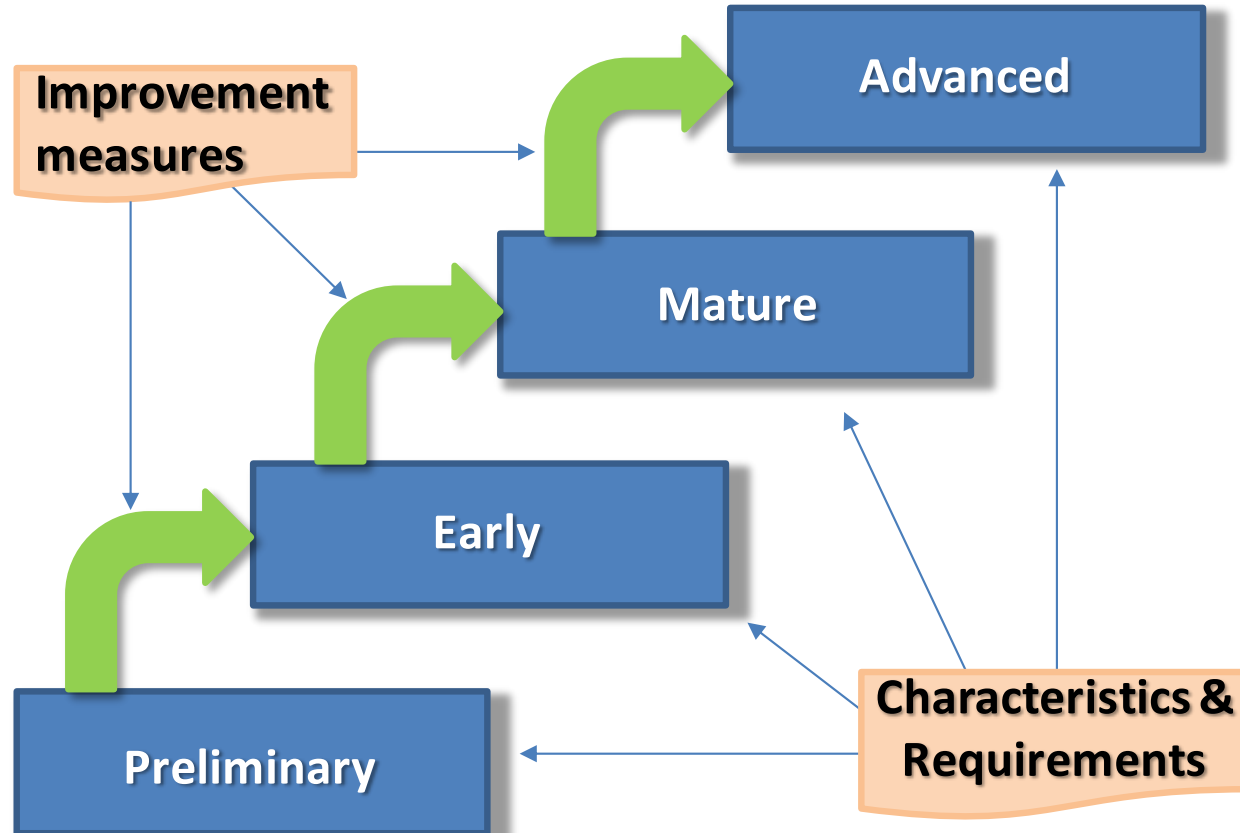

Conceptual visualization SBR MM



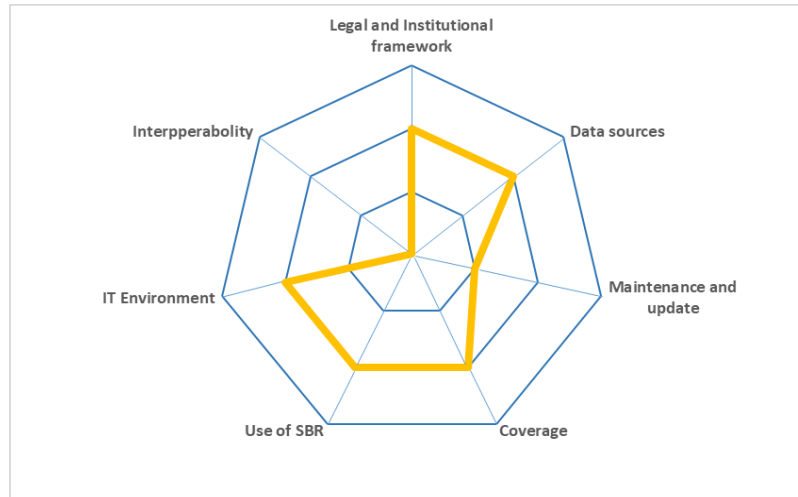
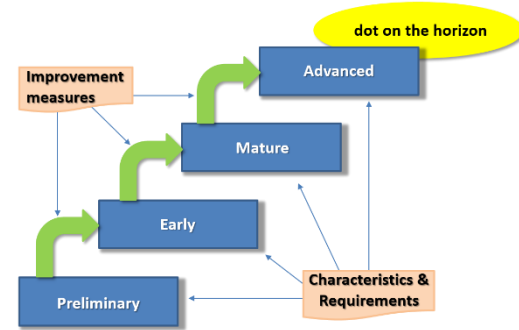
Statistical Business Register Maturity Model

- Seven dimensions
 1. Legal and institutional framework
 2. Data sources for SBR
 3. Maintenance and update of SBRs
 4. Coverage of a SBR
 5. Use of SBR
 6. IT environment
 7. Interoperability
- Four maturity stages:
preliminary, early, mature, advanced



Self Assessment

- Based on the maturity model
- For each dimension, a set of question to assess the stage of development



Global Assessment on the SBR

- Intended to be regularly conducted to
 - To have a global overview of the status of implementation of SBR in countries
 - To identify priority areas for technical assistance and topics for further methodological guidance and future work
- Built on the self assessment with additional questions
- Supported by the UNSC at its 53rd session in 2022
-some overlap with Country Progress Report



How to coordinate?

A possibility is to:

- Combine the Country Progress Report of the Wiesbaden Group and the global assessment
 - Extend the Country Progress Report with additional questions from self assessment
- Adjust current CPR application for future CPR/global assessment rounds (by UNSD and the Wiesbaden Group)
