Introducing ESP

As a global community, we are totally dependent upon the natural world. It supplies us with every oxygen-laden breath we take and every mouthful of food we eat. Ecosystems deliver various ecosystem services (ES) that underpin our human well-being. The loss of biodiversity and degradation of ecosystems has an increasingly negative impact on society and businesses and runs through all sectors and communities.

Although the need for sustainable development is widely recognised, as a society, we still need to find a sustainable relationship with our natural environment. An integrated approach to human-environment interactions is essential to bridge the gap between long-term ecological goals and short-term economic interests. The Ecosystem Services Partnership (ESP) was initiated in 2008 in response to these challenges.

ESP is a global network that connects ecosystem services scientists, practitioners, stakeholders, and policymakers at local, national, regional, and international scales on different sustainability topics. As ESP, we aim to enhance communication, cooperation, and coordination within the fields of sustainability by building a solid network of individuals and organisations that work on the topic of ecosystem services.

We facilitate this collaboration via the partnership's biome, thematic and sectoral working groups and national networks. Currently, there are more than 40 working groups and a growing number of national networks on all continents. The community gathers yearly at global and regional conferences.

ESP provides access to databases, guidelines, educational material, and many other services that help members and non-members enhance ecosystem services science and practical applications.

ESP Conferences

Since 2008, ESP organises yearly conferences on the science, policy and best practices of Ecosystem Services. This year, ESP is hosting its 5th European conference under the theme *Ecosystem Services: One Planet, One Health.* The theme refers to how the ecosystem services concept can address the challenges involved in delivering the global vision of One Health. It highlights the interdependence of human health, animal and plant health, ecosystem health, and the health of the global environment.

The theme aligns with international commitments under the Global Biodiversity Framework and is at the heart of the sustainable development goals. These goals can only be achieved in a healthy and fair economic system that takes the full value of nature`s contributions to human wellbeing into account.

Ecosystem services science can greatly contribute to addressing various sustainable development and global health challenges and presents a great potential for scientific partnerships across domains and for driving transformative change. ESP is the leading global community in the field of ecosystem services. ESP Conferences serve a vital function for this community, by providing space for knowledge exchange, networking, and innovation.

At the 5th ESP Europe conference, we aim to put a special focus on two thematic streams: a) Ecosystem services and health, and b) Ecosystem services and conditions for transformative



change. The streams are inspired by the overarching conference theme and will feed into the conference output and takeaways in different ways – with a unified purpose of scaling up the positive impacts of ecosystem services research. Of course, as always, there will also be ample room for session proposals that do not fit neatly in the layout of streams and conditions but do address relevant topics for the ESP community.

The conference will take place on 18-22 November 2024 in Wageningen, the Netherlands. The 5th ESP Europe conference will be an in-person conference to provide an enriching experience that allows attendees to fully immerse themselves in the conference, interact with speakers and engage with other participants in real-time. The conference will also make a dedicated effort towards empowering young voices. We are committed to enabling high-impact participation of early career researchers. The program will be completed by preconference trainings, a conference dinner, and field trips showcasing local landscapes.

Conference goals

- Connect different stakeholders to address the main challenges in achieving One Health
- Enhance the knowledge of participants about the interconnections between ES and health
- Provide networking opportunities for international ES professionals from different sectors: governance, science, society, and business
- Provide participants with the opportunity to strengthen and/or create new ideas, projects, and partnerships
- Provide a promotion space for organisations, companies, and institutions with sponsor booths throughout the week and stands during the ES marketplace.
- Target over **500 delegates** from various countries around the world.
- Enable high impact participation of early career researchers.
