The protection of your personal data is very important to us. It is important to us to inform you about what personal data is collected, how it is used and what design options you have.

### 1. Who is responsible for data processing? Who is my contact if I have questions about data privacy at Telekom?

### 2. What rights do I have?

You have the right to,

- a. to request information on the categories of data processed, the purposes of processing, any recipients of the data, the planned storage period (Art. 15 DSGVO);
- b. to request the correction or completion of incorrect or incomplete data (Art. 16 DSGVO);
- c. revoke a given consent at any time with effect for the future (Art. 7 para. 3 DSGVO);
- d. object to data processing that is to be carried out on the basis of a legitimate interest for reasons arising from your particular situation (Art. 21 (1) DSGVO);
- e. in certain cases, within the framework of Art 17 DSGVO, to demand the deletion of data - in particular insofar as the data is no longer required for the intended purpose or is processed unlawfully, or you have revoked your consent in accordance with (c) above or declared an objection in accordance with (d) above;
- f. under certain conditions, to demand the restriction of data, insofar as deletion is not possible or the obligation to delete is disputed (Art. 18 DSGVO);
- g. to data portability, i.e. you can receive your data that you have provided to us in a common machine-readable format such as CSV and, if necessary, transfer it to others (Art. 20 DSGVO);
- h. complain about data processing to the competent supervisory authority (for telecommunication contracts: Federal Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information; otherwise: State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of North Rhine-Westphalia).

### 3. Who does Telekom share my data with?

To processors, i.e. companies that we commission with the processing of data within the scope provided by law, Art. 28 DSGVO (service providers, vicarious agents). Telekom remains responsible for the protection of your data even in this case. We commission companies in the

following areas in particular: IT, sales, marketing, finance, consulting, customer service, human resources, logistics, printing.

To cooperation partners who provide services for you or in connection with your Telekom contract on their own responsibility. This is the case if you order services from such partners from us or if you consent to the involvement of the partner or if we involve the partner on the basis of legal permission.

Due to legal obligation: In certain cases, we are legally obliged to transmit certain data to the requesting government agency. Example: Upon presentation of a court order, we are obliged under Section 101 of the Copyright Act to provide owners of copyrights and ancillary copyrights with information about customers who are alleged to have offered copyrighted works on Internet file-sharing networks.

4. Where is my data processed?

Your data will only be processed in Germany.

5. What data is collected, how is it used and how long is it stored?

Your personal data (first name, last name and e-mail address) will be collected and processed exclusively for the execution of the event and, if applicable, for sending a feedback sheet on the event. At the end of the event, your data will be deleted immediately, unless it is required due to legal proof or retention obligations.

You will receive a confirmation e-mail (DOI e-mail) to identify your e-mail address. The personalized link in this DOI e-mail is valid for 24 hours. Please confirm the link immediately upon receipt so that your registration data is stored in full and participation in the event is possible.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 (1) lit. b of the General Data Protection Regulation.
