Lance M McCracken is Professor and Head of Division in Clinical Psychology, Psychology Department, Uppsala University, Sweden, since 2018. He completed a post doctoral fellowship at Johns Hopkins in 1994, and was employed at The University of Chicago, in Psychiatry and in Anesthesia and Critical Care. He was Clinical Lead at the Bath Center for Pain Services in the UK, beginning in 2000, and left that post to take up a post as Professor of Behavioral Medicine at King's College London in 2011 until 2018. He now has more than 30 years of clinical and research experience mainly in psychological and interdisciplinary approaches to chronic pain. He conducts clinical research and his interests include contextual behavioral science, psychological treatment development for chronic pain, digital interventions, and single case experimental methods.
