1. Who is responsible for the processing of your personal data?

This event is organised by the European Forum of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (EfVET), which is the data controller in charge of the processing of your personal data. 2. What is the purpose of the processing?

Your personal data will be processed in order to:

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 5(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, as the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest.

The EfVET exercises its tasks as set out in Articles 300-304 of the [Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union](#). Further details concerning the purpose of this event are set out in the invitation.

4. What personal data are processed?

The following personal data will be processed

- information necessary for your registration: title, first name, last name, country, e-mail, phone number, name of organisation, job title

Your consent is required for

- photos, audio and video recordings and web streaming related to this event
- attendee list containing your name and affiliation, which will be shared among participants
- invitations to future events the EfVET may organise

You can provide your consent via the event registration form online or at the registration desk on the first day of this event.

5. Who are the recipients or categories of recipients of your personal data?

The recipients of your data will be the EfVET staff in charge of the organisation, management and follow-up of this event.

We will never share your personal data for direct marketing purposes.

Photographs and/or audio and video recordings could be published in the context of this event and in the framework of EfVET and/or activities on the web, including via social media. If need be, the files containing the video materials may be slightly altered (for example, brightness and contrast) so that they can be used for the purposes for which they were taken.
