

Draft Program Overview

The **ESP Summer School 2026 program** combines morning theory sessions with afternoon practical work on ecosystem services modelling, biodiversity indicators, and spatial analysis. The week is organized into four thematic blocks: opening and framing, carbon and climate regulation, biodiversity and habitat quality, and cultural services and recreation.
