

Steven Kamper

Dr. Steve Kamper is a Professor of Allied Health at University of Sydney and Nepean Blue Mountains Local Health District and NHMRC Investigator Fellow (EL2). Steve is a physiotherapist by training and ranked in the top 10 researchers in the world by *Expertscape* in the fields of pain (4), musculoskeletal pain (1), back pain (6) and Physiotherapy (3). He has over 200 publications including in top-ranking general medical (BMJ, JAMA, PLOS Medicine) and field-specific (Pain, Brit J Sports Med, J Clin Epi) journals which have been over 9000 times. His current work is supported by >\$6M in competitive NHMRC/MRFF funding since 2016. He conceived and writes the 'Evidence in Practice' series of articles in the Journal of Orthopaedic and Sports Physical Therapy (ranked 2/68 Rehabilitation journals) which is used in pre and post professional training programs for clinicians in more than 10 countries. Professor Kamper's work underpins clinical practice guidelines for low back pain globally and has had direct impact on nationally mandated insurance reimbursement policy in the Netherlands. He is regularly invited to present at academic conferences (incl. The 2022 Bonica Lecture at the Australian Pain Society), clinician education meetings, science outreach events, on podcasts and online interviews and in mainstream media. His role at Nepean Blue Mountains Local Health District involves training and supporting clinicians to embed research into their clinical services, and working with health service executive to design services supportive of research activity.
