

MIST Event Registration - Terms & Conditions

By registering for the MIST public event organised by MIST you are agreeing to comply with the following terms and conditions.

Data Privacy

MIST is committed to data privacy and protecting your personal information. By submitting your email address during the event registration process, you agree that the organiser may send you event-related information. A valid email address is required for all registrations.

MIST uses the personal data you provide in this registration for administering your participation in this event. This may include information about the event's content, updates, and additional information related to the event.

MIST may disclose your personal data to third-party service providers engaged by MIST to assist in the conduct of the event. Except as described herein, MIST will not disclose your personal data to any other third party without your consent except where required to do so by law.

Nondiscrimination policy

MIST prohibits discrimination, harassment, and bullying against any person for any reason, e.g., because of age, ancestry, colour, disability or handicap, national origin, race, religion, gender, sexual or affectional orientation, gender identity, appearance, matriculation, political affiliation, marital status, veteran status, or any other characteristic protected by law.

Event conduct and safety

MIST is committed to providing a safe, productive, and welcoming environment to all participants, including staff and vendors, at the event. MIST has no tolerance for discrimination, harassment, or bullying in any form at the events. Participants are expected to adhere to these principles and respect the rights of others.

What to do if you witness or are subjected to unacceptable behaviour: Participants should report any behaviour inconsistent with these principles to onsite event staff. Event staff will be happy to help participants contact venue security or local law enforcement, provide escorts, or otherwise

assist those experiencing harassment to feel safe for the duration of the event. We value your attendance.

Liability waiver & release

In consideration of registration and participation in the event, you hereby warrant and represent that you freely waive, release from liability, assume all risks, and covenant not to sue IEEE or its members, employees, board members, agents, or volunteers for any expense, loss, damage, personal injury, including loss of life, illness, including but not limited to COVID-19, disability, property damage, or property theft or actions of any kind that you may hereafter suffer or sustain before, during, or after the event, unless said expense, loss, damage, personal injury, including loss of life, illness, disability, property damage or property theft or actions of any kind is caused by the sole, gross negligence of MIST.

Service as an invited speaker

If you agree to speak at the MIST event, we may share your contact and biographical information with event attendees. Sometimes we may also request a photograph. In other cases, we post on the respective event website information such as your name, employer, physical work address, and work email address, as well as a link to your company website and/or professional LinkedIn page available to the public. This is so that visitors to the event website, including event attendees and speakers, can contact you with questions and requests for more information, and to provide feedback if needed.

Usage of photographic and video material taken at MIST events

To comply with global data privacy laws, MIST imposes certain restrictions on the use of multimedia at its events (e.g. photography, video, audio, online streaming, and all future mediums). An attendee is permitted to use hand-held cameras and/or smartphones to take photographs and capture digital images for personal, non-commercial use, provided the photography is not disruptive. Photographs may not be published, sold, reproduced, transmitted, distributed or otherwise commercially exploited in any manner whatsoever.

MIST may hire professional service providers (photo/video/streaming/audio) to document and display the event experience. MIST may also use social media (e.g. LinkedIn) to post real-time photos and videos to its social media feeds. Attendees and MSIT partners are encouraged to capture their event experiences and post their social content from the event (text, photos, audio, video, streaming), provided it does not infringe upon the rights of any attendee, or MIST partners. Such infringement would include but is not limited to, defamation or infringement of intellectual property rights.

By attending the event, you acknowledge and agree as follows: (a) MIST may edit and use footage it captures at the event for its further activities and any other lawful purpose in the ordinary course of

its research; and (b) due to the prevalence of mobile recording devices in today's world, MIST disclaims all liability for the capture of your image in any multimedia format by other attendees at the event.

MIST reserves the right to change, amend, add or remove any of the above Terms & Conditions in its sole discretion and without prior notice. If one or more of the conditions outlined in these Terms & Conditions should become invalid, the remaining conditions will continue to be valid and apply. These Terms & Conditions apply to all event participants (attendees, speakers, project partners).
