

General Terms and Conditions for Training of the Dutch Society for Diving Medicine

Definitions:

Dutch Society for Diving Medicine (DSDHM/NVD): the scientific society for diving and hyperbaric medicine, registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number 40481721, with its statutory seat in Utrecht.

DSDHM/NVD Website: the website duikgeneeskunde.nl and/or any other website managed by the DSDHM/NVD, for example duikkeuring.nl, duikartscertificering.nl or any other (future) DSDHM/NVD website.

Training: an activity organized by the DSDHM/NVD in which knowledge transfer takes place within the framework of education (e.g. the MED, DMP, and HMP courses) or continuing education (e.g. (interactive) webinars, scientific meetings, etcetera)

Participant: a person who has registered for the Training

Coordinator: the person who coordinates the training on behalf of the DSDHM/NVD board (course leader/course director in the case of the MED, DMP, or HMP training, moderator in the case of webinars or in-person continuing education, or otherwise where applicable).

ECB: European College of Baromedicine (<https://www.ecbm.eu/>)

ECB Certifications: Certification awarded by the (ECB) in accordance with the Standards of the ECHM-EDTC as published in the document “ECHM-EDTC Educational and Training Standards for Diving and Hyperbaric Medicine 2011”, or subsequent updates. The certifications are:

MED: Medical Examiner of Divers (Level 1),

DMP: Diving Medicine Physician (Level 2D),

HMP: Hyperbaric Medicine Physician (Level 2H)

EDM/EHM/EDHM Expert in Diving Medicine / Expert in Hyperbaric Medicine / Expert in Diving and Hyperbaric Medicine (Level 3).

Direct transfer: payment via iDEAL, Wero, or a similar transfer method.

1. Registration

1. The Dutch Society for Diving Medicine (DSDHM/NVD) is an ECB-accredited training institute and provides ECB-accredited training for physicians.

2. In the event that a training course is also accessible to persons other than physicians, this is explicitly stated.

3. The training course is announced via the DSDHM/NVD Website.

4. Those interested in the training can register via the DSDHM/NVD website. Upon receipt of the registration, the participant will receive a confirmation. Applications are processed in order of receipt.

5. For training and educational purposes, personal data may be shared with lecturers, accreditation bodies, and any accommodations. The DSDHM/NVD is responsible for handling personal data responsibly and carefully. These personal data will be processed in a proper and careful manner and in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act and the General Data Protection Regulation.

2. Execution of the agreement

1. The DSDHM/NVD will fulfil and execute the agreement to the best of its knowledge and ability based on the state of scientific knowledge known at that time.

2. If and to the extent that proper execution of the agreement requires this, the DSDHM/NVD has the right to have certain activities performed by third parties.

3. Termination of the agreement

1. The DSDHM/NVD reserves the right to cancel the training in the event of insufficient participation. The DSDHM/NVD will inform registered participants of this as soon as possible, but no later than 1 week before the start of the course. In the event of cancellation, course fees already paid will be fully refunded.

4. Payment

1. Payment for the training is made immediately upon registration. After completing the registration form, the participant pays via direct bank transfer.

2. Participants who have not registered for a training course but are present at the training may, if there is still space, register on the spot and also pay on the spot via direct bank transfer. The coordinator determines whether there is still space for a non-registered participant. 3. A registered participant will receive an invoice immediately.

5. Cancellation conditions

1. Cancellation must be made in writing or by email.

2. Cancellation up to 4 weeks before the start of the training is free of charge.

3. In the event of cancellation between 4 and 2 weeks before the start of the training, 50% of the course fee will be charged.

4. In the event of cancellation within 2 weeks before the start of the training, the DSDHM/NVD is entitled to charge the full course fee.

5. After registration, the participant has a statutory cooling-off period of 14 days and may cancel their participation in the relevant training free of charge within this period, unless registration takes place after the registration deadline. In this case, training-related costs (e.g., catering) will be charged.

6. The DSDHM/NVD reserves the right to cancel the training in the event of illness of instructors or other unforeseen circumstances.

6. Property Rights of the DSDHM/NVD

1. All intellectual property provided by the DSDHM/NVD to the participant for use remains the property of the DSDHM/NVD.

2. None of the Training Material may be reproduced, stored in an automated data file, or made public in any form or manner, whether electronic, mechanical, by photocopies, recordings, or any other means, without the prior permission of the DSDHM/NVD. The Training Material, in both written and electronic form, may not be used outside of DSDHM/NVD training without the written permission of the DSDHM/NVD.

7. Final Provision

In all cases not provided for by these conditions, the Board of the DSDHM/NVD shall decide.
