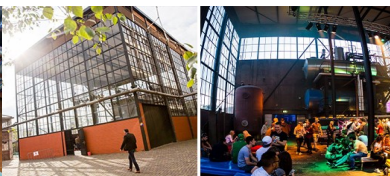
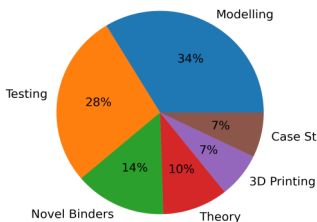

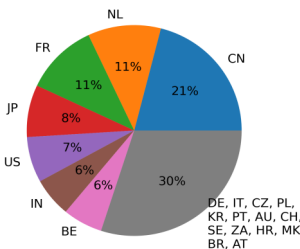
**“Lijm & Cultuur” The old glue & gelatine factory** boasts a rich history. In 1885, Jacob Cornelis van Marken – renowned for the Dutch Yeast and Spirit Factory and the Dutch Oil Factory (NOF) – established a glue and gelatine factory on the land between Rotterdamseweg and the Schie. The factory endured wars, crises, social changes, and an explosion but, partly due to the BSE crisis, ceased operations in 2002. Since 2003, however, a remarkable transformation has unfolded on the premises and within the remaining monumental buildings: a shift from the production of gelatine and glue to the production of culture.
