MUST SEE ATTRACTIONS

<u>The Uppsala Castle</u> which houses two beautiful museums: <u>Uppsala Art Museum</u> and the <u>Vasaborgen</u>. A visit to the castle be incomplete without taking in the serenity of the <u>Uppsala</u> <u>University's botanical garden</u> where you will find greenery and flowering plants all year round.

<u>Viking Burial grounds, runestones and the Gamla Uppsala Museum</u>: Walk the 1000-year-old paths of Old Uppsala and explore the ancient Viking burial grounds.

<u>Uppsala Cathedral</u>: The largest cathedral within the Nordic countries and a key Swedish cultural monument since its inauguration in 1435.

<u>Gustavianum</u>, <u>Uppsala University Museum</u>: Uppsala University's oldest preserved building has served as a space for education since its construction in 1622.

Linnéträdgården: The first botanical garden in Sweden founded in 1655 by Olof Rudbeck.

<u>Stadsträdgården</u>: The city garden offers a beautiful green space by the Fyrisån river, which runs through Uppsala.
