

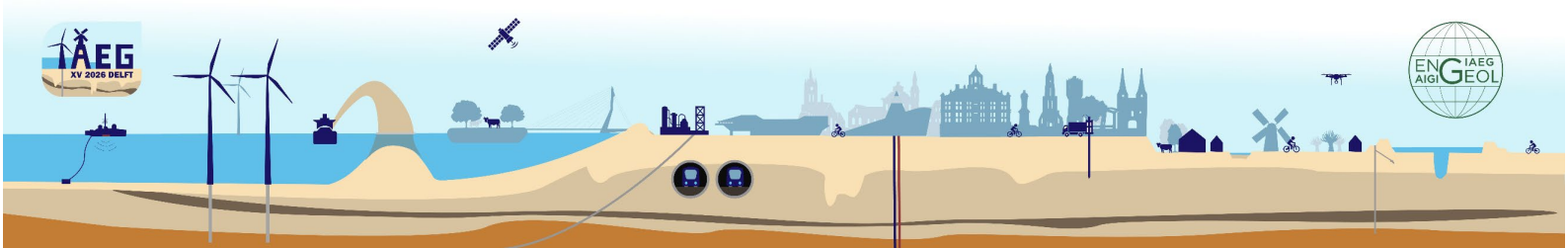
# EnGeOlympics Rules 2026

## Logo Design Contest



### Organisation





The **EnGeOlympics** are Engineering Geology Games for future makers. They consist of several contests, among them the Logo Design contest. The EnGeOlympics are organized as part of the **XV IAEG World Congress 2026**, hosted at Delft University of Technology, Delft, the Netherlands. The competition is coordinated by the EnGeOlympics Organising Committee.

## 1. General Rules and Regulations

- Participants cannot be more than 40 years old on the date of the event.
- There is no cost to register or participate in the Logo Design Contest.
- The logo must be an original creation of the participant or team submitting it. A team may not consist of more than 2 members.
- Logos cannot be created with the use of AI, but AI can be used for inspiration purposes. Authors may use AI tools to improve their figures, provided they carefully disclose the tools used and how they use them.
- Each participant or team may submit only one design.

## 2. Purpose of the Competition

The aim of this contest is to design an original logo that will feature the EnGeOlympics for the future. The winning logo will be printed on the shirts awarded to the winning team of the 2026 EnGeOlympics Logo Design Contest.

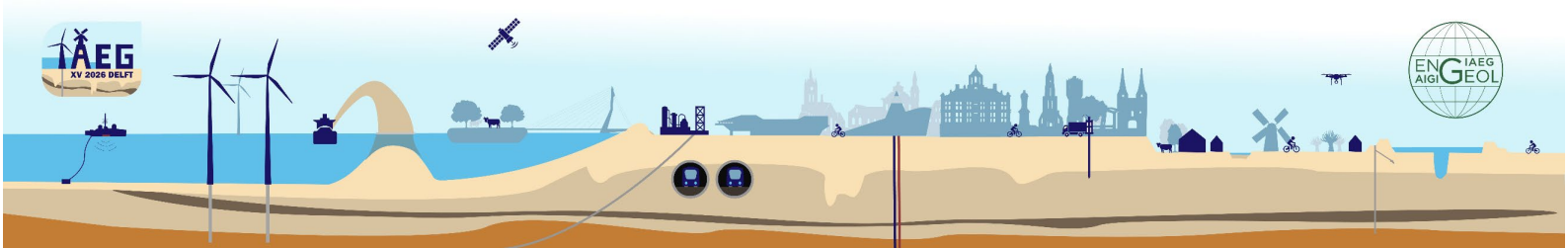
## 3. Communication

- All communication will be conducted exclusively in English.

## 4. Submission Guidelines

- The deadline for logo submission is 1 October 2026.
- The logo must be submitted to the following email address:

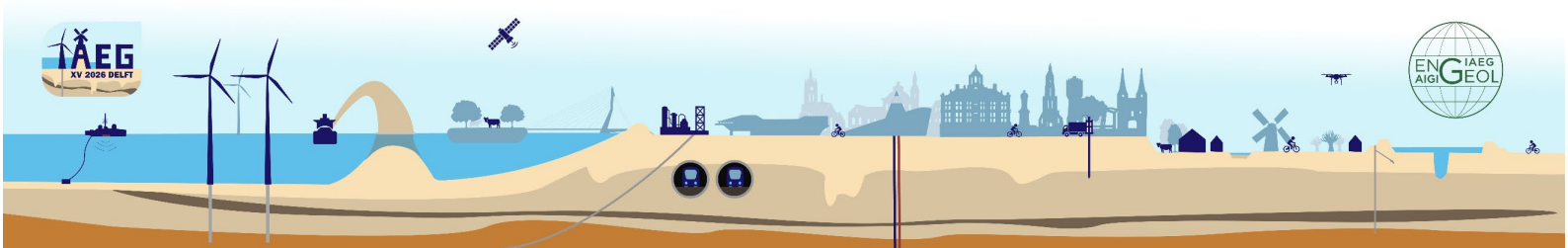
- The subject of the submission email must be formatted as “Logo Contest Submission - [replace this field with contestant name or team name]”.
- The following information/documents must be submitted alongside the logo:
  - Full name(s) of participant(s)
  - The logo design file (see format specifications below)
  - A piece of text of at most 100 words explaining the logo.
- The creator(s) of the winning logo must grant the IAEG2026 World Congress and the IAEG full copyright for distribution and printing purposes.

## 5. Logo Design Specifications

- The logo must be suitable for digital use (website, banners, etc.).
- The logo must be suitable for a “full back” T-shirt print (see front page). The logo’s width should be between 25.4 and 35.6 cm, and the height should be between 30.5 and 40.6 cm.
- The logo will be printed on a T-shirt, not embroidered. The T-shirt shall be white or black, depending on the winning logo.
- File format: .PNG with a minimum resolution of 300 DPI or .SVG, both with a transparent background.
- File size: less than 5 MB
- Both colored and monochrome versions may be submitted.

## 6. Evaluation and Selection

- The submitted logos will be evaluated by a panel of five judges appointed by the board of the 2026 EnGeOlympics Organising Committee.
- Criteria for evaluation:
  - Creativity and originality
  - Relevance to the EnGeOlympics theme
  - Visual impact and clarity



## 7. Awards

- The winning logo will be printed on the shirts awarded to the winning teams of all EnGeOlympics events.

- The winner (or winning team) will:
  - Be announced during the closing ceremony of the XV IAEG World Congress 2026.
  - Receive an Official certificate of achievement.

## 8. Important Dates

- Opening of applications: 1 April 2026
- Submission Deadline: 1 October 2026
- Announcement of winner: Thursday, 5 November 2026, during the closing ceremony of the IAEG 2026 World Congress in the Auditorium of Delft University of Technology Congress Center, the Aula.

## 9. Changes in the Rules

- The competition rules are subject to modification if approved by the IAEG 2026 EnGeOlympics Committee.
