

Due to other events taking place in Maastricht, a part of the city is closed off. This may affect your route to the Sint Janskerk. Therefore, we recommend you to take the following route (see map above and description below) if you plan to come by car on June 3.

Follow the A2 to the Viaductweg in Maastricht and take exit 53 from the N2:

- 1. Merge onto the A2/E25, keep to the left and continue on the A2.
- 2. Take the exit towards Maastricht and merge onto the A79.
- 3. Continue to the N2 and follow the three right lanes to take exit 53 towards Hasselt.

Take the Noorderbrugsingel, Cabergerweg and Statensingel to the Vrijthof in Maastricht-Centre:

- 1. Merge onto the Viaductweg and continue on the Noorderbrugsingel.
- 2. Turn left onto Cabergerweg and turn right onto Statensingel.
- 3. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Hertogsingel. Turn left onto Calvariestraat and follow the road to Kommel.
- 4. Turn right onto Brusselsestraat and take a slight right turn onto Oude Tweebergenpoort.
- 5. Continue to the Keizer Karelplein and continue to the Vrijthof.
- 6. The entrance to the car park is on your right.

Alternatively, insert "Calvariestraat" as a via-location, with destination "Q Park Vrijthof" on your GPS application.
