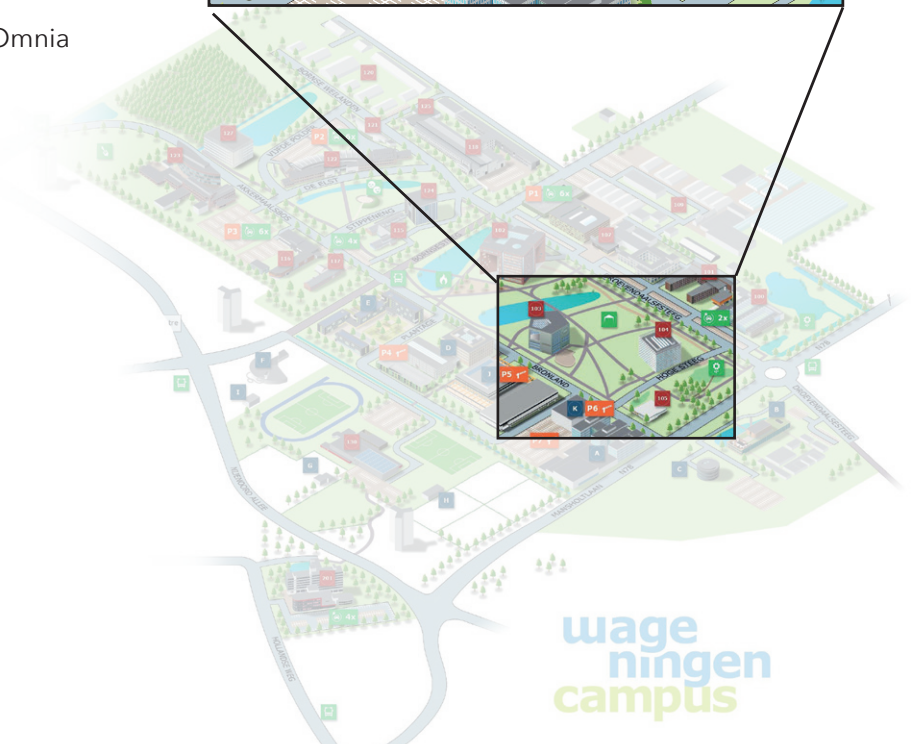
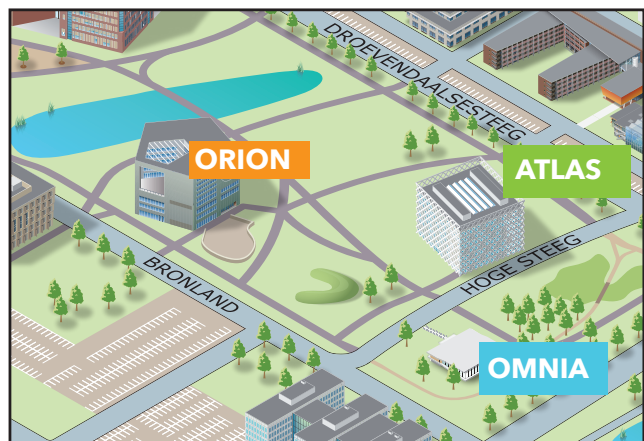

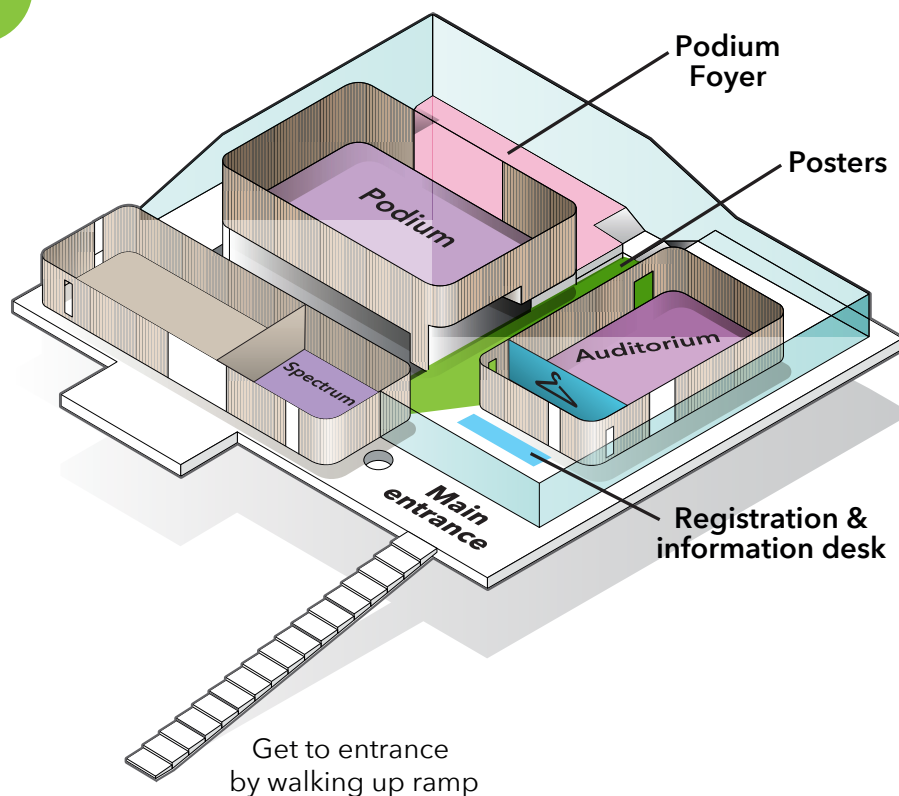
Floorplan

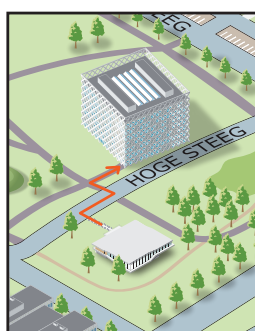
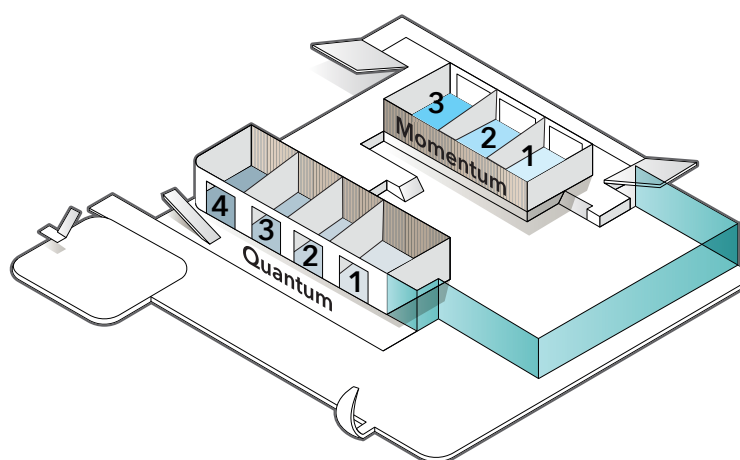

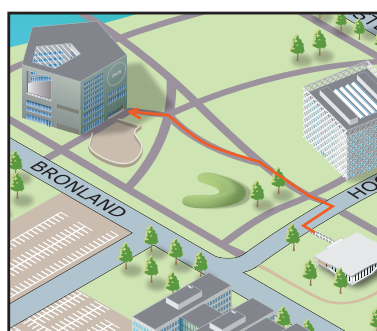
