

## Curriculum vitae: Professor Dr. Guy Brusselle (MD, PhD):

## **Summary**:

Guy Brusselle received his medical degree (M.D.) at Ghent University in 1990. Investigating the functional role of cytokines interleukin-4 (IL-4) and interleukin-5 (IL-5) in allergic asthma, he obtained his Ph.D. in 1997. As a respiratory physician with a keen clinical and scientific interest in asthma, severe asthma and COPD, he joined the Ghent University Hospital in 2002. Since 2008, he is professor of medicine at Ghent University, teaching the courses "Study design" and "Respiratory Medicine" to medical students at the Faculty of Medicine.

Currently, he is head of the Laboratory for Translational Research of Obstructive Pulmonary Diseases at Ghent University, and of the Department of Respiratory Medicine at Ghent University Hospital.

From 2012 to 2015, he has served the European Respiratory Society (ERS) as Guidelines Director. From 2016 till 2019, he has been the chair of the ERS Science Council. Since September 2017, he is member of the Scientific Committee of the Global Initiative for Asthma (GINA) and he has joined the Board of Directors of GINA. Since January 2023, he is the president of the Belgian Respiratory Society (BeRS).
