In this presentation Terry will be examining the development of social work in Central Asia with a particular focus on understanding the development of social work in the region as a postcolonial experience, given the former Russian and Soviet era invasion and domination of the region during the 19th and 20th century, with its attendant suppression of local culture . The challenge of integrated practice between modern social work developments and pre-Soviet Islamic mahalla systems will also be considered, as colonial era Soviet models of practice are superseded and replaced.
